

General Camps



Pre-K (age 3) - Kindergarten

\$515/week

Half-Day (9am-1pm) or Full-Day (9am-4pm) camp program featuring daily swim lessons, snack, lunch, and activity choices. See sample schedule online.

Traditional Day Camp

Rising 1st - 6th graders

\$715/week

Full-Day program offering morning swimming lessons, snack, lunch, several activity choices, and afternoon free swim each day. See sample schedule online.

Teen Leaders Adventure Camp

Rising 7th - 9th graders

Cost varies by session

Two-week leadership and adventure-based program where each session teens will engage in activities on-campus as well as a number of adventurous, off-campus field trips. Additional information and sample activities can be found online.

C.I.T. Level 1

Rising 10th Graders

\$1.725

Two separate Three-Week sessions designed to teach our older campers about working with younger children as well as general leadership skills.

C.I.T. Level 2

Junior Counselor

\$600

This One-Week intensive training for rising 11th graders, and/or graduates of CIT Level 1, is designed to help our NEW leaders: identify the qualities of good camp counselors, practice skills that will help them be successful leaders and role models, and receive one-on-one mentoring from the CIT Director. Participants can choose up to three additional weeks to volunteer as a Junior Counselor.
